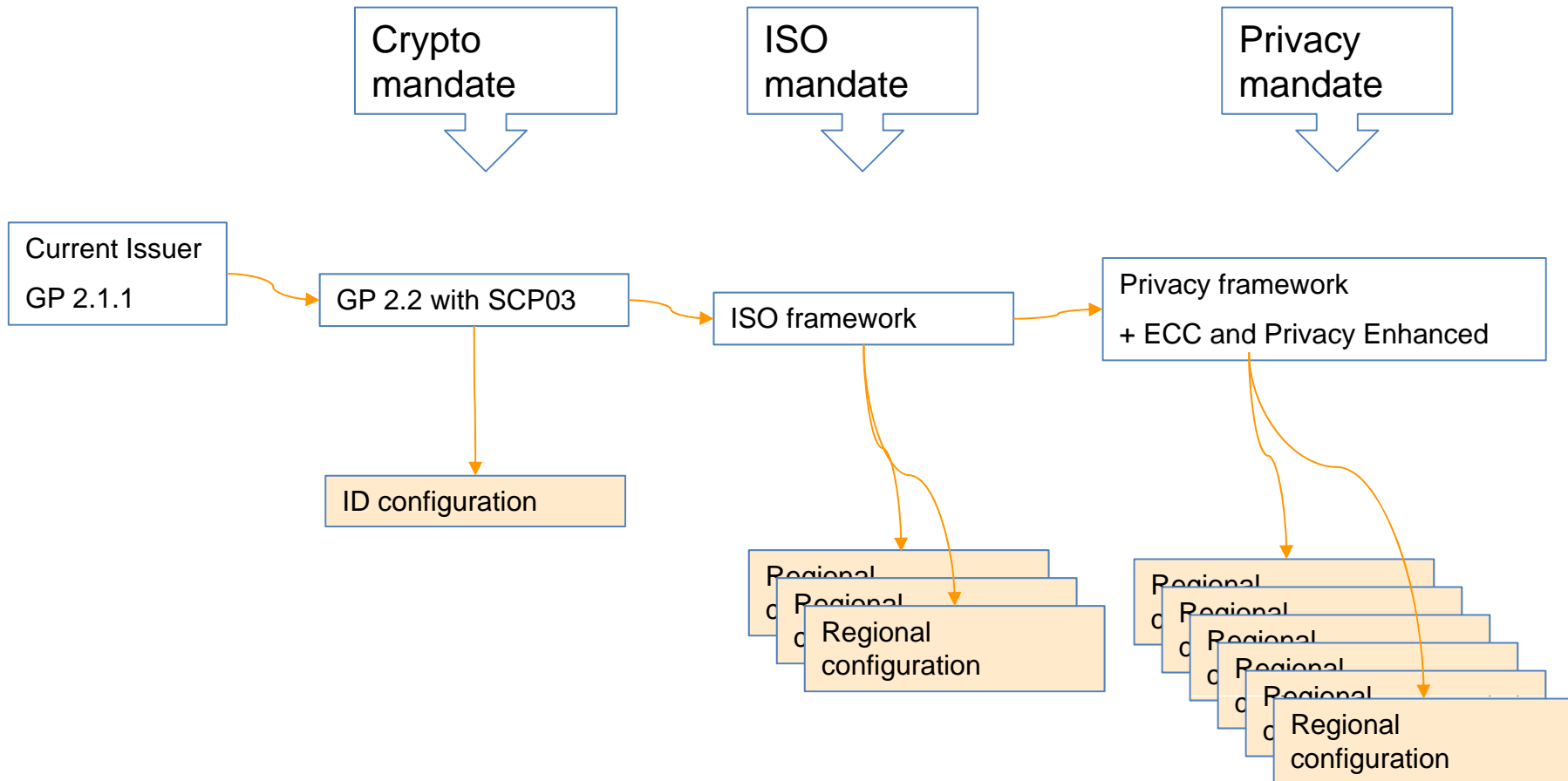


GlobalPlatform Government Task Force- Charter



- Promote GlobalPlatform specifications at the Government level
- Educating and informing government issuers, consultants and integrators about the benefits that an open and interoperable environment can bring to their program
- Addressing the long-term needs of governments engaged in large-scale e-ID deployments for both government-to-employee and government-to-citizen
- Have GlobalPlatform specifications written into or referenced by the National or International Standards, so that GlobalPlatform cards get deployed:
 - GP Authentication protocols in ISO/IEC 24727
 - ISO/IEC 7816-13 Annex B
- Collect the requirements of Government Agencies
- Improve the value of GlobalPlatform specifications for Government Programs:
- Ease collaboration across National standards bodies

The GTF road map for Government is now in “production”

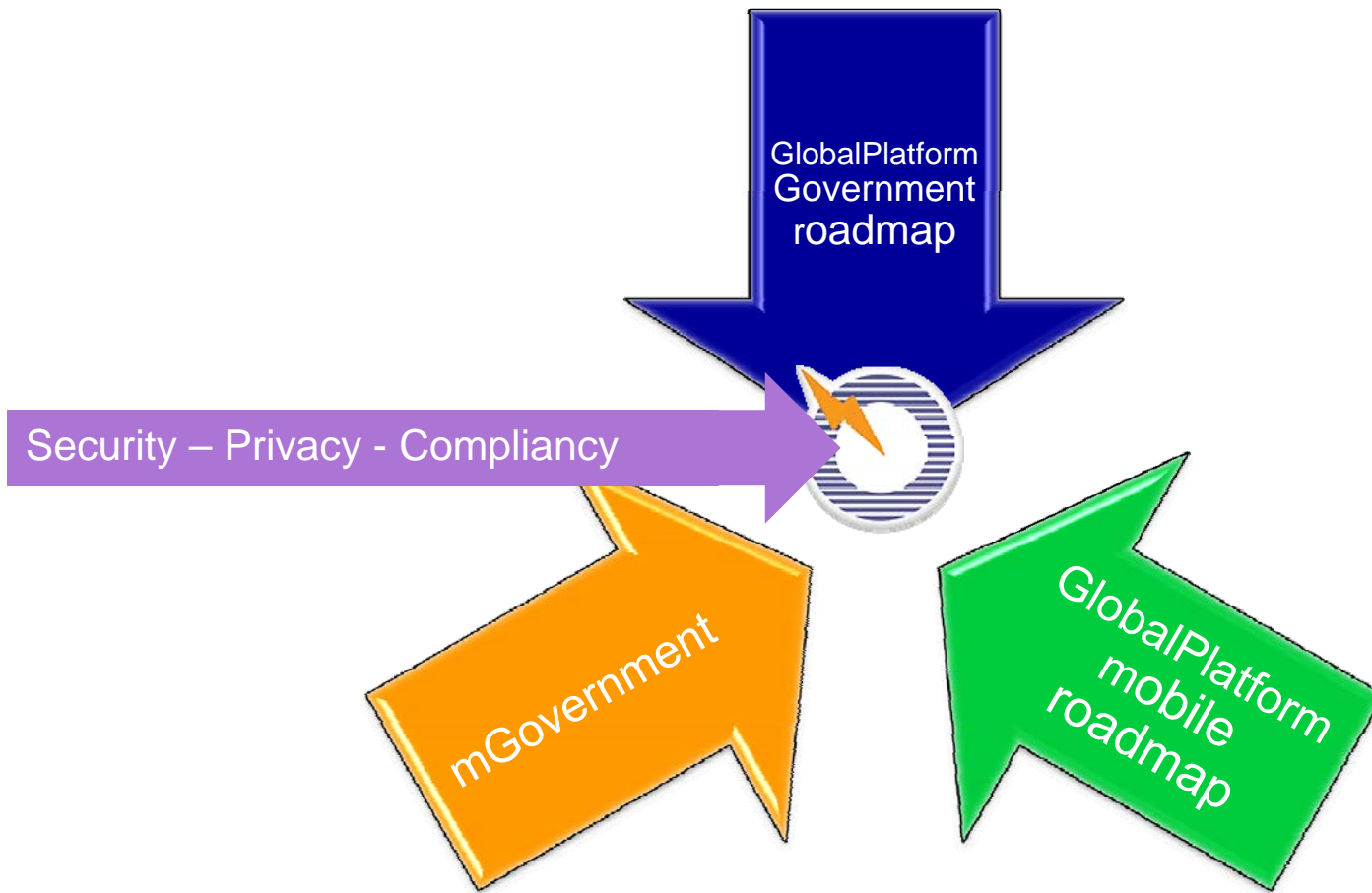


- ISO framework is a result of GlobalPlatform effort on convergence between
 - ISO committee
 - ISO 7816-13 (based on GlobalPlatform contribution)
 - ISO 7816-4
 - ISO 24727 (Middleware)
 - Countries
 - US and the ANSI 504 (GICS) standard under finalization (based on GlobalPlatform contribution). ISO Alignment will be achieved as part of Amendment 1
 - Japan with ISO 7816-13 objective
 - GlobalPlatform expertise on multi-application management

- Starting 2013 Government Task force is introducing the concept of local chapter meeting open to non member Government agencies
- Completed such event with US Government session, March 20th, 2013, with positive feedback.
- Question for the audience, is there a Government forum/event we should target in region.?

- Privacy by design
 - Delivered to Card Committee for review.
- ID Configuration
 - Certification program is in process of being updated to support basic configuration
 - Protection profile being studied to define priority
- GP for ID white paper
- Continue effort on convergence
 - The ISO framework is ending the Native vs GlobalPlatform competition
 - Eurosmart convergence project on eID card specification used in Europe
 - True multi application require collaboration across issuers.

 - TEE and Government
 - Derived credential concept
