Outline .. 1

- **Title of event** : NFC CEPAS PlugFest
- **Primary scope** : Testing of CEPAS enabled NFC phones with reader terminals. Many to many interoperability testing. Open to transit and non-transit terminals, unrestricted. Door access readers, PC based readers are allowed as well
- **Optional secondary scope** : NFC phones working as reader terminals, test reading of CEPAS cards, SSID-cards, e-passports, another NFC CEPAS phone.

Outline .. 2

- **Start date** : tentatively Q2 or Q3 2013
- **Duration** : anticipate 1/2 day to 1 day duration per session. Likely to have follow up repeat sessions 2-3 weeks later.
- **Location** : some room in Singapore (LTA or IDA, or any)
- **Test guideline and scripts** : to be developed, may grow in complexity as work progresses.

- **Who can participate** : unrestricted, local and international organisations
- **Participation fee** : free
- **Result** : letter of successful participation, not meant to be a certificate of compliance
- **Benefit** : to help companies discover problems and improve their products (or standards)
